DESIGN PROCESS

Consultation: Our design process begins with a complimentary consultation in one of our three showrooms where we will discuss the scope of your project, review any inspiration photos, and understand your lifestyle, needs and ideas with consideration to your budget. Once you feel satisfied and are ready to proceed, a retainer would be collected to begin your cabinetry design. The design retainer fee depends on the scale of the project, which typically ranges from \$1,500 to \$5,000, and may be applied towards the price of the cabinetry at the time the order is placed.

Design: The design process typically takes 2-4 weeks, depending on the scale of the project. We begin the design of your custom or semi-custom cabinetry by first, collecting measurements, taking photos, gathering site information, and then creating a custom design concept based on all the information gathered during and after the initial meeting.

Proposal: Once the design has been completed, we will present the rendering(s), basic floorplan(s) and proposal to you, which can be done either by appointment at one of our showrooms or by emailing the documents directly to you for review. After review and approval, a signature and a 50% deposit are collected.

<u>Order:</u> After you sign your custom proposal, we typically have all of the necessary information and your cabinet order can be submitted. However, some projects may benefit from additional client meetings to finalize the design and selections.

<u>Delivery and Installation:</u> Once your custom cabinetry has arrived at our storage facility, you will be notified and the remaining balance will be collected prior to scheduling delivery to the jobsite. If needed, we can store your cabinets for a monthly storage fee and we also offer installation services and can arrange for one of our experienced installers to quote and install your cabinetry.
